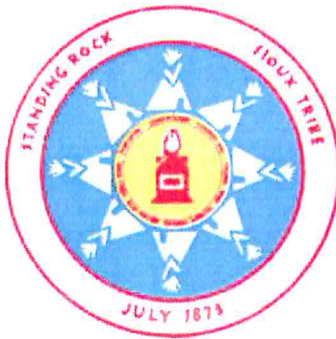

COLORECTAL CANCER AWARENESS MONTH

MARCH 2011

WHEREAS, colorectal cancer is the third most common cancer for Northern Plains Native Americans,

WHEREAS, colorectal cancer occurs more often in the Northern Plains Native Americans tribes than Whites and Native Americans in other regions of the US except Alaska,

WHEREAS, colorectal cancer accounts for more cancer deaths than any other type of cancer except lung for the Northern Plains Native Americans,

WHEREAS, for the Northern Plains Native Americans, colorectal cancer is detected more often at later stages when it is more difficult to treat,

WHEREAS, the earlier that colorectal cancer is detected, the higher the survival rate. Regular screening is recommend, especially for men and women 50 years and older,

NOW, THEREFORE, I Charles W. Murphy, Chairman of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe, do hereby proclaim March 2011 as Colorectal Cancer Awareness month and do encourage all citizens of Standing Rock to screen for cancer and to support research in the month of March.
